### Non-Acid Restroom Cleaner

**N.A.C.** is designed for use where housekeeping is a prime importance. When used as directed, this powerful, ready-to-use formula will clean and disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces such as walls, sink tops, furniture, telephones, shower stalls, bathtubs, hampers, cabinets, and bedsprings. N.A.C.'s disinfecting action kills the HIV-1 (AIDS virus). In addition, N.A.C. will deodorize those areas that are generally hard to keep fresh smelling such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, basements, and restrooms. EPA Registered.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

<u>DISINFECTING</u>: Apply **N.A.C.** by mop, sponge, cloth, or spray on hard, non-porous surfaces for a minimum contact time of ten minute in a single application. For disinfecting, remove gross food particles and heavy soil deposits, then thoroughly wet surfaces. Rinsing is not necessary on floor surfaces which are to be waxed or polished. <u>CLEANING & DISINFECTING TOILET BOWLS</u>: Remove or expel over the inner trap residual bowl water prior to applying use solution. Use 4 ounces of **N.A.C.** in toilet bowl. Squeeze **N.A.C.** around bowl and under rim. Then scrub thoroughly with brush. For urinals, add 4 ounces of **N.A.C.**. Then scrub thoroughly with a brush for a contact time of ten minutes.

<u>MILDEWSTAT</u>: Apply **N.A.C.** by spraying, making sure to wet all surfaces completely. Let air dry. Repeat application weekly or when growth reappears. See label for further instructions.
